CIRCULAR

Sub:- 22nd Sub-Junior National Tennikoit Championship for both Boys and Girls under 14 years of age for the year 2007, from 19th to 23rd Nov,2007 at Yawtmal, Maharashtra,, conducted by Maharashtra Tennikoit Association at Dr.Babasaheb Nandurkar College of Phy.Education, Sree sathya sai Kreedha Nagari stadium, Yawathmal..

RULES

1. Each State shall send 16 members i e., Boys Team: 6 Players, 1 Coach and 1 Manager.
Girls Team: 6 Players, 1 Coach and 1 Manager.
2. Good free boarding & lodging will be provided for 16 members only (one day before and one day after the championship).
3. The age limit to participate in the championship is as follows:
Boys and Girls born on or after 01.04.1993 are ONLY eligible. Age certificate issued by the Head of the Institution where the candidate is studying is only valid. A passport size photograph should be affixed on the certificate and shall have the signature of the Principal / Head Master on their Photographs. No player will participate in the championship without submission of the AGE CERTIFICATE as mentioned above. Participation / Merit Certificate will not be issued without affixing the Photograph of the player.
4. Railway concession forms for Officials / Players are also enclosed for availing Railway concessions.
5. Each State shall bring 2 Nos.Of their State Flags.
6. Team Championship will be played on League/Knockout (DAVIS CUP BASIS).
7. Latest rules of the Tennikoit Federation of India shall be followed.
8. All players shall play their matches with their State Colour and Sports Canvas Shoes. Uniforms, which shall have Chest Numbers from 1 to 6 only with State Name, shall be used.

IMPORTANT: Register 5 players for team championships in Boys and Girls section and 1 player each for mixed doubles.

- a) All players who have registered their names must play in the Championships. From among the registered players 2 shall play in doubles and other 2 in open singles. No certificate shall be issued to players who have not played in any matches. Players shall play with proper uniforms.
Boys: Half Pant, "T" Shirt with State Name, Chest No. 1 to 6 and Canvas Shoes
- b) Winner/Runner up of Junior National Championship in the previous championship is / are NOT ELIGIBLE to participate in this sub-junior National championship 2002 in the open individual event.
